Speak O Lord till your church is built, and the earth is filled with your glory. **Bible readings Deuteronomy 30 vv 11-20**

This commandment that I lay on you today is not too difficult for you or beyond your reach. It is not in the heavens, that you should say, 'Who will go up to the heavens for us to fetch it and tell it to us, so we can keep it?' Nor is it beyond the sea, that you should say, 'Who will cross the sea for us to fetch it and tell it to us, so that we can keep it?' It is a thing very near to you, on your lips and in your heart ready to be kept. Today I offer you the choice of life and good, or death and evil. If you obey the commandments of the Lord your God , conforming to his ways, and keeping his commandments, statutes and laws, then you will live and increase, and the Lord your God will bless you in the land which you are about to enter to occupy. But if in your heart you turn away and do not listen, and you are led astray to worship other Gods and serve them, I tell you here and now that you will perish and not enjoy long life in the land which you will enter to occupy after crossing the Jordan. I summon heaven and earth to witness against you this day: I offer you the choice of life or death, blessing or curse. Choose life and you and your descendants will live; love the lord your God ,obey him, and hold fast to him; that is life for you and length of days on the soil which the Lord swore to give to your forefathers, Abraham Isaac and Jacob.

Mark 4 vv 26-34. Jesus said' The kingdom of heaven is like this. A man scatters seed on the ground; he goes to bed at night and gets up in the morning, and meanwhile the seed sprouts and grows-how, he does not know. The ground produces a crop by itself, first the blade, then the ear, then full grain in the ear; but as soon as the crop is ripe, he starts reaping, because harvest time has come. He said, How shall we picture the kingdom of God, or what parable shall we use to describe it. It is like a mustard seed; when sown in the ground it is smaller than any other seed, but once sown, it springs up and grows taller than any other plant, and forms branches so large that birds can roost in it's shade.'With many such parables he used to give them his message, so far as they were able to receive it. He never spoke to them except in parables; but privately to his disciples he explained everything. **Sermon** One of the biggest changes during the life-time of most of us, is the amazing amount of choices that have become part of our daily lives. Any colour as long as it is black -was Henry Ford's motto in 1922 But nowadays cars come in many different colours and shades. The supermarkets' shelves have many varieties of food and drink and so we could go on. Think of the choices you may have already made today morning What time to get up.....what to have for breakfast...dinner ...tea. What to wear.....Making choices is one of the things we learn to do as we grow up-living with the consequences of those choices comes a little later. Asserting our right to choose ,but then blending that right with the choices of others is all part of learning to live as part of a family ,part of wider society Choosing- choice- a very important –a vital part of our lives as human beings

Our Old Testament lesson today was about choice Moses has spent many years leading the people of Israel out of Egypt and through the wilderness. He knows how easy it is..... for all sorts of reasons....for them to follow their own path rather than trying to follow God's ways In this passage- towards the end of his life- when he is about to hand over the leadership to Joshua; he reminds the people of all that God has done for them in the past and challenges them to choose life-follow the way that God leads Knowing that that is the way which will give them the best life possible. It's a choice not only for the Israelites but for each one of us; whether we will as Jesus described it on one occasion Try to love the Lord our God with all our heart, with all our soul, with all our mind and with all our strength and our neighbour as ourselves. Or whether we will choose to go our own way ,live just for ourselves....do our own thing. Paul in his letter to the Corinthians, described it as a new creation.... Being made new ,when we choose to offer our lives to God. Choose life Moses said to the Israelites; Choose life God says to each one of us today.

Choose life the most important decision we will ever make.

Choose life a decision that can be made at any time in our lives.

Choose life a decision that needs to constantly be renewed.

Choose life a decision that our weekly worship-our prayers our Bible reading helps us to put into practice.

Choose life a decision that's not always easy to make, that's not always easy to live with ;but which can bring so many unexpected blessings and outcomes. Making a choice to go with God opens us up to possibilities that are not always apparent at the beginning. Jesus story about the tiny mustard seed which we heard earlier from Mark's gospel, reminds us of how sometimes very small beginnings, can produce amazing results that are way out of proportion to our expectations. In my own life seeing and then answering an advert in the Methodist Recorder; while responding to another advert for pens for a school fair, led to three years working in the East end of London. Not something I had ever expected to do, completely different from my previous experience in rural Norfolk; but an experience which enriched my life so much, as well as giving me necessary experience which meant I was accepted for future ministry. Choosing life can bring so many unexpected blessings and outcomes; not only for ourselves but for others too. Last month Christian Aid week, gave us the opportunity to give a small amount of our own money, to projects which would make a huge difference to the lives of other people; and that is true of course not only of the work of Christian Aid, but many other organisations both in Britain and in other countries of our world. Our choosing life, our gifts of money but also gifts of ourselves in many other ways can be a very precious gift to others.

So too is the ability to make choices. I was fascinated to read a story of residents in a care home, who complained to the cook that they were only ever offered vanilla ice-cream. Could they not have strawberry or chocolate for a change.-they asked. The following week three flavours were offered — as it happened only vanilla was chosen, but everyone was happy and felt better because there was now an option to choose. Choosing life-choosing to follow God's way. The most important choice we will ever make. A choice that can bring so many unexpected blessings and outcomes to ourselves and to others, enabling them to have the freedom to make choices too.

But...... you don't need me to tell you, that choosing life, choosing to follow God's way is challenging. Just as on a long car journey we have to make many decisions which way to go, so to on our journey through life we have to continue to make choices, seek God's will, seek God's help. The writer of our last hymn John Bode sums it up so well in lines like

I shall not fear the battle if thou art by my side Or wander from the pathway if thou wilt be my guide O speak to reassure me to hasten or control.

Yet in spite of the truth of those words; how often we try to do things on our own. Sometimes we think we don't need any help; sometimes we are reluctant to take the time to reflect, think about, pray about a situation, seek God's help. Yet the more we can learn to depend on God rather than ourselves; the easier we will find it to choose life. Learn to depend on his strength which never falters His wisdom which has an answer for every situation His power which as Paul wrote so movingly to the Ephesians,- A power within us which is able to do immeasurably more than all we ask or imagine His guidance-always dependable-always looking out for us—choosing the best way for us His peace—which again Paul describes as being beyond human understanding His comfort in times of hurt or anxiety. Such wonderful resources, strength, wisdom, power, guidance, peace, comfort, always available to us only a prayer away.

Choose life Moses challenged the Israelites. Choose life God constantly challenges us Choose life, accept my offer of a new creation and be part of my kingdom; a kingdom where the smallest 'seed 'can have amazing results. Choose life-the life in all its fullness that Jesus offered to us.

Life in 21 century Britain brings with it many choices- the most important-To choose life May we each find much joy, hope, peace as well as challenge as we follow that path Amen.
